What are cookies?

Also known as browser cookies or tracking cookies, cookies are small, often encrypted text files, located in browser directories. They are used by web developers to help users navigate their websites efficiently and perform certain functions. Due to their core role of enhancing/enabling usability or site processes, disabling cookies may prevent users from using certain websites.

In short, TDSi uses cookies to make your experience of our website better. We do not use cookies in an intrusive manner; all cookies that are used on the TDSi website are purely for functional and operational purposes.

What cookies does TDSi collect?

The TDSi website collects the following cookies for the purpose of continually improving your experience online.

- **Necessary cookies** - These are required for the normal function of this website such as logging into client areas.
- **Analytical Cookies** - Anonymous data about your visit is recorded and used to help us improve the website.
- **Tracking Cookies** These cookies allow us to understand your flow and interaction through the website so we can make improve navigation
- **Social Cookies** - These allow you to easily share content with your network. These Social Media Sharing icons also use Cookies to record who has shared what content.

Where is the data sent and to whom it is shared?

TDSi respects your privacy so we will not sell your data to third parties, allow any access to the data that isn't necessary to honour any other contracts we have in place or store excessive amounts of data we no longer need. All data is stored within the website.
